Teacher Encounters is an opportunity for businesses and schools to work in partnership on developing a shared understanding of:

- how subject knowledge can be contextualised
- how businesses communicate with young people
- how and what green skills are taught
- how young people can access green careers

Using evidence to improve student outcomes

A strong school careers programme reduces the likelihood of students being not in education, employment or training and increases the uptake of apprenticeships.

Careers programmes have the biggest effect on those in the most disadvantaged circumstances.


All of last year's teachers said that engaging with employers:

Collaboration and Challenge

Teacher Encounters challenges all participants to reflect on existing practice, then develop and embed new practices that seek to improve outcomes for young people.









In the West of England, Teacher Encounters focus on green skills: the values, knowledge and competences employers need to help them work towards a more just and sustainable society.




- Register


