

BECOMING A STEM AMBASSADOR



Becoming a STEM Ambassador is simple:

1. **Sign up via www.stem.org.uk/register** to get started and create your STEM profile, letting us know a bit about you and what you may like to do as a volunteer.
2. **Complete our STEM Induction training**, this is an online training that covers an introduction to volunteering with us and child safeguarding.
3. **The final step is completing a DBS Check**, which is free for all volunteers. A DBS Check involves an online DBS Application followed by a digital ID Check.

SUPPORT FOR STEM AMBASSADORS

You can become a STEM Ambassador as an individual and support STEM events on your own, or if you're keen to support schools and colleges alongside your colleagues then you can also get involved together! However you choose to get involved, you will be a part of a nationally recognised programme working together with schools, universities, youth organisations, employers & institutions to better support young people to access STEM and careers related opportunities.

- STEM Learning offers a wide variety of support, training and CPD via the [Training Hub](#). These training sessions are delivered online and are free to access for all STEM Ambassadors who would like to develop their skillset and confidence.
- Opt in to sector specific schemes that may complement your industry focus or long term goals.
- Your STEM profile will allow you to access volunteering opportunities, and record events you have supported. Your activity log is downloadable, as is your volunteering impact report, allowing you to see a data snapshot of the reach and impact of your volunteering.
