WHAT IS FIRST® LEGO® LEAGUE?

FIRST® LEGO® League (FLL) is the world's largest youth STEM competition, inspiring students, volunteers, and employers alike. For volunteers and employers, participating in FLL is an opportunity to nurture passions in young people while contributing to social value. For young people, aged 9-16 years, FLL inspires curiosity and confidence through hands-on STEM learning. The challenge theme encourages them to explore real-world topics and develop an understanding of engineering challenges.



REGIONAL TOURNAMENTS

All participating teams are invited to attend a regional FLL tournament. This is an opportunity for student teams to showcase their robot design, participate in a series of robot games and share their Innovation projects. These exciting and energetic events bring together hundreds of young people to compete, have fun, and engage with employer sponsors.

South West England **Founders Edition** tournaments are delivered, in partnership, by Graphic Science (Bristol, Somerset & Wiltshire), Cognition Learning (North Cornwall & Plymouth) and Cornwall County Council (South Cornwall). During the 2026/27 Season this delivery partnership will co-host a single combined **Futures Edition** tournament for all new teams across the South West.

FOUNDERS EDITION TOURNAMENTS

The **Founders Edition** of FIRST LEGO League will use the current LEGO SPIKE™ Prime technology. SPIKE™ Primes have been the principal kit for the past 7 years. The 2027-2028 season will be the final year that teams can compete using this kit, as FLL gradually transitions to new kit (see **Futures** below). The 2026-2027 South West **Founders** tournaments will host over a thousand students from more than 90 primary, secondary and special schools across the region.

FUTURES EDITION TOURNAMENTS

The **Futures Edition** will introduce the new Computer Science & AI LEGO kit, launching for the 2026-2027 season. This kit aims to integrate computer science and artificial intelligence into the classroom and extracurricular offerings. The new kit and FLL challenge retains its playful character while being expanded with new elements, including wireless hardware with integrated functions alongside task models with integrated hardware.
